Brussels Embassy scales down operations in light of National Public Health Reaction to the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The Embassy of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana to the Kingdom of Belgium advises that as it continues to monitor the national reaction to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak in Belgium, the Embassy has scaled-down operations until further notice.

In an effort to safeguard the health of our visitors and members of our staff, the Embassy has suspended immediately in-person consular services and non-essential visits to the Embassy, with the exception of applicants requiring urgent travel documents.
